# INAUGURAL ASSEMBLIES

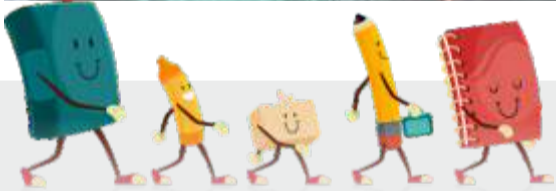

### Teacher's Workshop

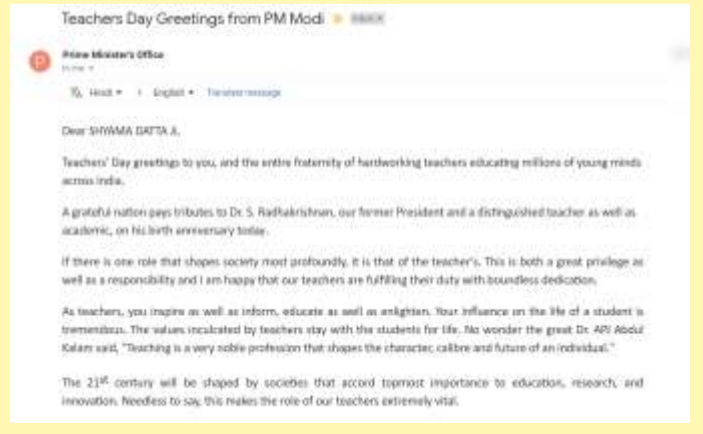
Teachers were coached and guided in a workshop organized at our school. The agenda was about Class Room Management and Do's and don'ts of it.
