How to make lunch- box healthy?

Children consume a third of their daily nutrients while at school therefore it is important to give them healthy food. Here are some vital tips for parents:

- Nothing out of packet for breakfast.
- Avoid plastic lunch boxes.
- Don't put hot food in aluminum foil or news paper.
- Include more colours in the food prepared; a child of growing age must have five raw fruits and raw vegetables in a day.
- Remember a simple rule whatever your grandparents ate is best for you.

Top five foods that child should eat right during season change:

Sesame (til), Jaggery (gud), Millet (bajra), Dry fruits & fresh fruits ,
Homemade ladoos or halwa.

Last but not least a child come to school after a fasting of 8-10 hrs so to remain active for a day session, a lunch box should be power pack. Remember healthy parents only raise healthy children, so start with you. Suggestive food for good immunity-
Roti+ ghee+ jaggery, Lemon sharbat+ ginger+ kesar+ black pepper,
Begin the day with a local fresh fruit, Eat tulsi leaves (5-6)
everyday. Vegetable juice/ fruit juice are good option to start a day than a glass of milk, as some students feel nauseous after having milk.

India's Anti-Satellite Missile Test Is a Big Deal.



India's unexpected launch of an anti-satellite missile test sparked surprise (and some alarm) among international and aerospace-industry experts. The test's success makes India the fourth country capable of destroying an enemy satellite, after the U.S., Russia and China. An anti-satellite weapon, or ASAT, is

anything that destroys or physically damages a satellite. That's the broad definition.

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi declared on Wednesday (March 27) that the country had pulled off an ASAT missile launch that same day. The launch, "Mission Shakti," likely struck an Indian satellite in low Earth orbit, turning the object into debris.

ASATs take many shapes, but the clearest examples follow kinetic-kill models, in which an object in space or on the ground is sent to collide with an orbiting satellite, destroying both object and target with the energy of the crash.
