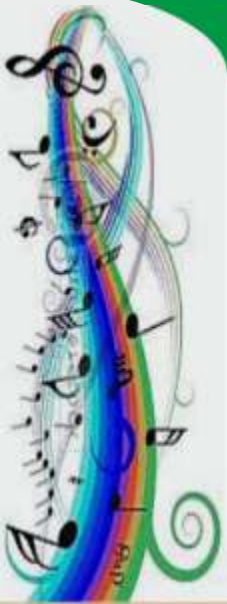

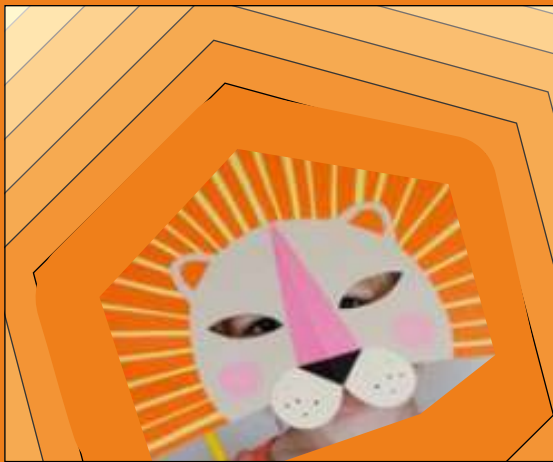

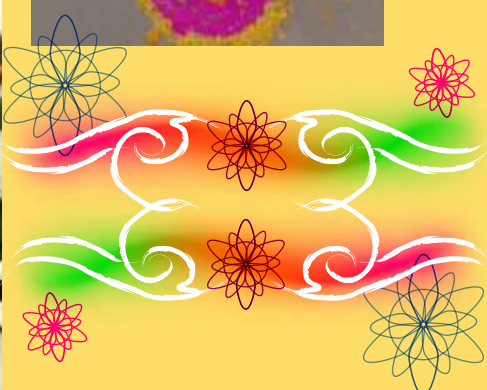

## STATUE OF UNITY



- At 182 meters, Statue of Unity is the tallest statue in the world.
- Over 3,000 workers, including 300 engineers, built the statue within three-and-a-half years.
